Thank you for nominating either yourself or another deserving student for the 2022 IEEE/HKN Alton B. Zerby and Carl T. Koerner Outstanding Electrical/Computer Engineering Student of the Year Award.

All full-time Electrical or Computer Engineering Seniors receiving their first undergraduate degree in the academic school year September 1, 2021 - August 31, 2022 are eligible. Each chapter is restricted to one nominee.

Please be cognizant of the time frames and deadlines associated with this award as late submissions will not be accepted. The nomination process requires the completion of the two page form and the attaching of the other required information, a current resume, transcript (uncertified is acceptable,) portrait style picture, letters of recommendation if desired (it is recommended that the nominee provide letters of recommendation which may be attached to this form) and any other information the nominee deems pertinent. However, be advised that there is a twenty page limit on the size of the entire nomination package. Please note the nomination process requires signatures, and a quality picture, which may be published. Electronic (pdf) submissions or mailing of the original is acceptable, therefore plan accordingly. Remember, professionalism in preparation and presentation is important.

Attention, the committee strongly urges the nominee to complete this submission form and submit it to the committee as soon as possible. Upon receipt, time line permitting, the committee will review this form for adherence to and completeness of the process and contact the nominee if necessary to help the nominee address any concerns.

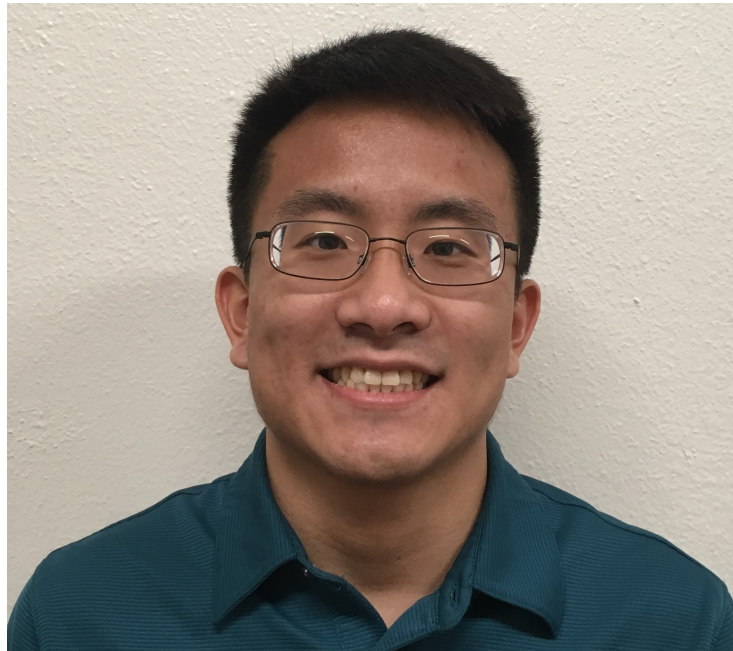
